

Greetings Family, Welcome to Spring!

Spring is a time for new beginnings, and I would like to share one with you.

In Isaiah, God says, ""Behold, I will do something new, now it will spring forth; will you not be aware of it? I will even make a roadway in the wilderness, rivers in the desert." (Isa. 43:19)

While this may be new to us, it is not new at all. It is something many churches do. It is a Membership Class that those interested in joining our church will attend. - 9. It prevents possible factions and problems.
- 10. While not a guarantee, a new member's class will help new members be faithful and effective members for years to come.

They are looking for a place to meet in the Oneco area where there is a significantly larger Haitian population. They have met with Pastor Gene with their Statement of Faith and their vision. This seems to be an opportunity for us to fulfil our mission statement. Our Leadership Council heard from their Pastor at our meeting on March 18, 2024. They have about fifteen members and are growing. They have an online presence in the area and are serving as Helping Hands Outreach in distributing food on Wednesdays each week.
